FROM THE CO-RECTORS

Jesus said, "You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit." John 3:7-8

The wind of the Spirit is blowing at Holy Trinity. As we write this, final preparations are underway for the Healing Conference. More than 100 people are registered and we look forward to a powerful experience of the Holy Spirit. We are very thankful for the dedicated work of Ann Lorelle and her wonderful committee.

As September approaches we are also preparing for the start of a new year of children's Sunday school. Many thanks to lead teachers Barbara Rahner (preschool), Joey Jachec (Godly Play for Kindergarten through 3rd grade) and Mary B Stallard (grades 4-5) and their many assistant teachers and helpers. Sunday school registration is underway. The Sunday school kick-off rally will be September 12 after the 9:00 service with special games and activities in the courtyard. Classes will begin on September 19 upstairs in Pearson Hall. We pray for the power of the Holy Spirit to open the hearts and minds of these young students. We also pray for the Power of the Holy Spirit to heal KC Crawley, our Children's Minister on medical leave from the staff.

The power of the Holy Spirit is also blowing through our Youth Ministry program. On September 8 we will welcome "JJ," Joshua Joseph, our new Youth Minister. JJ has worked for five summers

as a Camp Counselor and as Assistant Director at Camp Wingmann. Many of our youth already know him. His first activity with the youth group will be going to Night of Joy at Disney World on September 10 and 11. We are grateful for the work of Rick Jones, our Youth Minister for the past 2½ years and especially for his help during this time of transition. Rick will go on the Disney trip to help JJ get started. Rick has served quarter time, but JJ will be serving in a half-time position, as the Vestry has agreed for JJ to live rent-free in one of the houses owned by the church on Elizabeth Street as part of his compensation. Much prayer by everyone involved has gone into this transition and we are confident that God is moving powerfully to bring new and abundant life to Youth Ministry at Holy Trinity.

On September 12, following the 9:00 service, there will be a Parish Ministry Fair in the Parish Hall. Come and see how the wind of the Spirit is blowing in and through so many ministries in the life of Holy Trinity. The ministries represented at the Fair will include a wide range of activities that make it possible for members to use their gifts and talents to serve God. Explore the possibilities of what God may be calling you to do this fall!

One ministry in particular that is blossoming is Health Ministry at Holy Trinity. Carolyn Wilt, our new Faith Community Nurse, hired with the help of a grant from Health First to work two days a week, has already visited many shut-ins. We look forward to the Spirit forming and empowering a Health Ministry

Team this fall to extend this ministry.

We are always amazed at how powerfully the Holy Spirit is present when groups of Christians gather together for a meal. September brings two kinds of opportunities for meals. The first is our weekly parish dinner, prepared by Chef Daniel Farr. Please join your church family for dinner every Thursday evening! The second opportunity is Foyer Groups. The Foyers Super Supper will be the last Sunday in September. Sign up ahead of time to join a group; then come and meet your group for a fun potluck dinner. You will feel a part of the Holy Trinity family in a new and deeper way.

Vestry Member, Kerry Hanson, is chairing the parish stewardship program this fall. He has recruited a terrific committee to emphasize the theme: "As the Lord has blessed you, so you should give." Blessings have abounded in and through Holy Trinity for 125 years. Our church is historic and strong. The birth of our congregation happened over 125 years ago, and yet, as a family of God we are born again in every season that we allow the Spirit to direct our church. This fall the Wind of Blessing, the Wind of the Spirit, blows strongly. As your Co-Rectors we are so very thankful for your openness to the Spirit as together we experience renewal and growth.

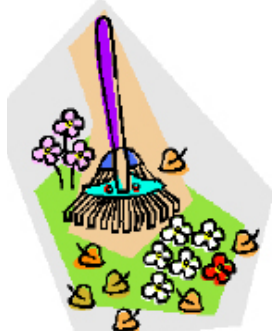
